SURGICAL REPORT

Re: Esah
Description: 1 year old bay Standardbred colt
Microchip: 985141007724265
Owner: Paul Renwick

On 20 November 2025 the above described horse underwent arthroscopic surgery of the right hock. A routine dorsal approach was made to the right tibiotarsal joint. A small fragment was removed from the distal intermediate ridge of the tibia and the subchondral bone was debrided to healthy margins. The joint was flushed. Portals were closed routinely.

Prognosis for athletic function is excellent.

Management:

1. Rest: please maintain the horse on box rest for two weeks followed by two weeks in a small yard.
2. Bute: give 6ml by mouth once a day for three days starting 21 November 2025.
3. Suture removal: please have sutures removed 4 December 2025.
4. Bandaging: please have the bandage changed every four days for three more bandage changes.

Intravenous and intramuscular injections have been administered to this horse. Please monitor the catheter, injection sites, and incisions closely. Please contact Prebbleton Veterinary Hospital if there are any signs of lameness, heat, pain, swelling and/or discharge.
